We are committed to a proactive approach to accident prevention in order to achieve continuous improvement in Health, Safety, Welfare and Wellbeing performance, and as a result we have committed to operate a health and safety management system in accordance with the requirements of ISO 45001.

This policy will be kept up to date and will be amended to suit any changes in the size or nature of the organisation's activities. In support of this intent the policy will be reviewed annually.

We have appointed a Health and Safety Officer (IMS Representative) to be responsible for Occupational Health, Safety, Welfare and Wellbeing matters. We have also nominated workforce representatives who provide a vital linkage between senior management and the shopfloor.

We will, where required, obtain advice on any relevant Health, Safety, Welfare and Wellbeing matters from appropriate external sources.
